



Optional POST-trip MAJORCA: August 13 – 16, 2026



Extend your stay for three nights on the enchanting western Mediterranean Island of Majorca!

We invite you to join this Majorca Post-Trip which is scheduled immediately after your Spain Total Solar Eclipse Expedition, August 3 - 13, 2026.

Immerse yourself in the culture, history, and natural beauty of Majorca with this enchanting extension that blends craftsmanship, wine and history. Relax on stunning beaches, explore the medieval streets and squares and unwind with local tapas and wine. This extension combines a glimpse of Majorca at its most authentic and captivating form.

ITINERARY

Day 1 (Thu Aug 13) Palma de Majorca. At leisure to engage in personal interests. You are free to sleep in after a late night celebration of our eclipse adventure. Take your time exploring the museums, shops and cafes of Palma or visit one of its splendid beaches on your own. Do as much or as little as you wish. B

Day 2 (Fri Aug 14) Journey to Northern Majorca. Discover the timeless beauty of northern Majorca on a full-day excursion through some of the island's most picturesque towns and coastal scenery. Visit the historic town of Pollença on a beautiful northern bay where sheer cliffs plunge into the turquoise Mediterranean. Explore the beautifully preserved medieval town of Alcúdia the with narrow lanes, charming boutiques and lively cafes enclosed by ancient walls. B

Day 3 (Sat Aug 15) Artistry, Tradition and Tranquility in Majorca's Heartland. Visit Majorca's most renowned glassworks, the Gordiola family glass factory, one of Spain's oldest family-run artisanal businesses. Then continue through the island's countryside to Oliver Moragues, a historic winery and estate set amidst rolling vineyards and olive groves. Dating back to the 13th century, this noble finca produces exceptional organic wines rooted in sustainability and heritage. Enjoy a guided tasting of their signature vintages, accompanied by light local delicacies, while learning about the family's centuries-old winemaking traditions. The day culminates atop Puig de Randa, where the Monastery of Cura sits serenely overlooking the island. Savor a leisurely lunch at the monastery's restaurant, featuring

traditional Majorcan cuisine paired with panoramic views stretching from coast to coast (*lunch cost additional*). The tranquil setting and fresh mountain air offer a perfect moment of reflection before returning to Palma. B

Day 4 (Sun Aug 16) Palma-Home Transfer to the Palma de Majorca (PMI) airport for onward flights. B
