On Monday, August 2, 2027 the yacht will be position in the center of the moons shadow approximately 135 nm from Valletta, near Latitude 33°53'1"N, Longitude 13°56'5"E to observe the Total Solar Eclipse with almost 6 minutes of Totality!

Leading this expedition will be astronomer Dr. Joe Llama. Joe is an astronomer at University of Texas, Austin, McDonald Observatory. He is a keen photographer and popular Betchart Expedition leader. He will provide a talk about the Total Solar Eclipse and evening stargazing.

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MALTA PRE-TRIP July 28 - July 31, 2027. Highly recommended for first time visitors to Malta.

VOYAGE DAY 1: EMBARK VALLETTA, MALTA

(Sat, July 31) Embarkation at the port of Valletta starts at 3:00 pm. Enjoy a welcome cocktail as the sun sets over Valletta's golden bastions. Welcome dinner onboard surrounded by the charm of the Grand Harbour. D

DAY 2: VALLETTA, MALTA

(Sun, Aug 1) Morning greets us with an enchanting arrival at Malta's beloved Gozo Island, home to the awe-inspiring Ggantija Temples. These remarkable structures — a UNESCO World Heritage Site — rank among the oldest free-standing monuments in the world, dating back over 5,500 years. DAY 3: TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

(Mon, Aug 2) Awaken to a day of celestial wonder as we reach our Total Solar Eclipse observation point. Experience this astonishing astronomical event from the comfort of your ship — minutes of awe shared under the darkened midday sky against the backdrop of the sparkling Mediterranean.

Our planned observation point, approximately 135 nautical miles from Malta, offers a possible duration of the totality just under 6 minutes, as the Moon passes across the center of the Sun

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DAY 4: SYRACUSE, SICILY

(Tue, Aug 3) Morning arrival in Syracuse, Sicily's enchanting "White City." After a delightful breakfast onboard, step ashore to explore this historic gem at your own pace or join our included guided tour to uncover Syracuse's rich heritage and cultural treasures.

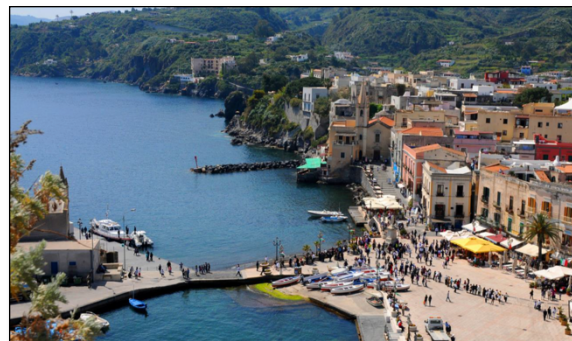

DAY 6: LIPARI ISLAND (AEOLIAN ISLANDS)

(Thu, Aug 5) Our yacht gracefully anchors at Lipari, the largest gem in the crown of the Aeolian Islands. Renowned for its rich mythology and breathtaking natural landscapes, Lipari beckons with irresistible charm.

Join an optional half-day Lipari tour (*fee*). A scenic coach ride takes us to Quattrocchi, where panoramic views of the Aeolian archipelago unfold before you. Next, we visit Quattropiani, home to a picturesque church and mesmerizing vistas of the island of Salina. The tour continues to a Spanish-built castle, once an ancient necropolis and now the site of a cathedral and museum filled with artifacts from prehistoric, Greek, and Roman eras.



After the tour, enjoy leisure time in the village for your own lunch arrangements. The afternoon is free to wander charming streets, relax by the sea, or explore Lipari at your own pace.

Before dinner, join us for one of our most beloved onboard events: the Cocktail Demonstration. Led by our skilled Bar Manager, this hour-long session showcases the creation of two signature cocktails, complete with recipes to recreate them for your friends and loved ones at home.

Alternatively, enjoy a scenic drive along the coast to Mount Vesuvius, where you can marvel at the volcano that shaped the region, or explore Naples’ historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site filled with narrow streets, bustling piazzas, and centuries of history. Voyages Fees: Are per person, twin share (*depending on cabin category*) cruise only, for 7 nights onboard *M/Y Voyagers*. Port taxes, air fare and land arrangements are additional. Port Charges additional \$595 per person (estimated rate, to be confirmed in 2027). Estimated air fare New York-Valletta, with return Naples-New York is \$1,295 per person. Air fares and port fees are subject to change.

Singles: We encourage all solo travelers to bring a roommate, or we may be able to pair you with a roommate. If you do not have a roommate, or we cannot assign one, you must pay the solo occupancy rate.

Triples: A limited number of cabins are available in Category A & P for triple occupancy (3rd bed is a sofa) with a discount of \$1,500 for the third person sharing a cabin with two full paying guests.

Expedition Fee Includes: Accommodations on board ship in comfortable yacht-sized cabin with private bath; buffet meals and Captain's Italian Night dinner, regular coffee, tea and drinking water on board ship; use of snorkeling equipment (subject to availability); group shore excursions in Gozo, Syracuse, Catania & Capri; tour leadership and lecture program; blanket gratuity to onboard shipboard staff; administration.

Expedition Fee Does Not Include: Air fare to Valletta, Malta with return from Naples, Italy; pre/post voyage accommodations, independent transfers, tours and other land arrangements; meals and expenditures incurred ashore; optional shore excursion in Lipari, any other excursions and activity unless explicitly listed as included; fuel surcharges; medical expenses; baggage, cancellation and personal insurance (emergency medical and evacuation coverage is mandatory); all items of a personal nature such as laundry, bar, beverage and communication charges; gratuities to leaders and local guides (guidelines will be provided); port taxes; baggage handling; alcoholic beverages, snacks, sodas, bottled water, laundry, internet use, passport and visa expenses; government arrival and departure taxes; anything not mentioned in voyage program.

What to Expect: This Expedition is planned for the travel enthusiast who would enjoy exploring crystal-clear turquoise Mediterranean waters, historic coastal towns, spectacular scenery and the intriguing history of Malta and Italy by Yacht, including the Total Solar Eclipse, August 2, 2027. Excursions and outing are on foot, be prepared to walk one-half to two miles over uneven terrain at archaeological sites, museums, and in cities at a pace suitable for exploring the wonders of the region. Stairs may not have hand rails, and elevators are not readily available. Malta and Italy have a Mediterranean climate. In the summer, temperatures can be quite hot and humid. Typically, it will be in the 80s & 90s with temperatures at night tempered by sea breezes dropping to the 70s. You will spend days outdoors in hot, sunny weather. Vehicles and buildings are air conditioned, but you must be prepared to prioritize hydration by drinking water often, not just when thirsty. Heat exhaustion can lead to heat stroke or other serious heat-related illness. If concerned, please consult your physician before joining this program. For safety reasons it is requested that physical disabilities of any kind be advised at time of reservation. It is understood that passengers requiring special attention or treatment must be traveling with a personal escort to assist them. This expedition is a tremendous experience for travelers with an appetite for adventure who have a keen interest in learning about the nature, history and culture of the region and seeing the Total Solar Eclipse, August 2, 2027. There are excellent prospects, but please keep in mind the sea has an element of unpredictability. We may encounter rough seas and winds during this voyage. There is always the chance overcast skies may hinder visibility, and that adverse conditions may alter the pre-planned route. The ship's captain has the final word on any decision made with regard to the vessel's itinerary, and it is understood that such decisions will be made in the interest of the safety of the vessel and all passengers on board. With this in mind, you will have a once-in-a-lifetime voyage of discovery and adventure.

M/Y Variety Voyager: Discover the Mediterranean at an un-rushed pace of 13 knots per hour, one island or seashore at a time. The contemporary state of the art 68-meter, 36-cabin Variety Voyager was launched in 2012 and complies with the most stringent SOLAS safety regulations. Her sleek lines and ample deck space redefining what yachting was meant to be. Warm fabrics, rich marbles, soft tones and wood-paneling are just some of the elements that define her. Please be aware that a small number of cabins may have a partially obstructed view due to the size of the porthole/windows and the design requirements of the ship. For example, some windows may be partly obstructed in the lower half by a gangway. The best view is always on the ample outer decks. The ship has stairs with hand rails, there is no elevator. Mingle with like-minded travelers in the main lounge and enjoy buffet breakfast and dinner in the dining room or al fresco. We look forward to sharing this magnificent journey with you!

Cabins: All cabins have private bathroom with marble floors as well as Glass and Corian showers, and are equipped with individually controlled A/C, TV with DVD player, mini fridge, safe deposit box, deluxe toiletries and bathrobes. Cabins with flexible bedding have 2 twins or 1 double.

Category C: Cabins are located on the lower deck offering oversized twin port holes. 3 cabins offer flexible bedding configuration. Category C: \$7,195 per person Double occupancy; \$10,975 Solo occupancy

Category B: Cabins are located on the lower and main deck offering oversized twin port holes (lower deck) or small double windows (main deck), 7 of the 11 cabins offer flexible bedding configuration.
